League Information:

Sand volleyball at Ten Pin Alley and Spike's is all about co-ed recreational fun. All skill levels are welcome. Some nights fill up faster than others so be sure to get your team registered early to secure your spot!

Registration:

In order to reserve your spot, participating teams will need to fill out a registration form completely and return it to Ten Pin Alley and Spike's.

Payment must be made in full at the time of registration. We will not accept any applications without payment. You may sign up for any or all sessions. Payments may be made in the form of CASH, CHECK, or Credit Card (Visa, MasterCard, Discover and American Express accepted). Checks made payable to "Ten Pin Alley and Spike's".

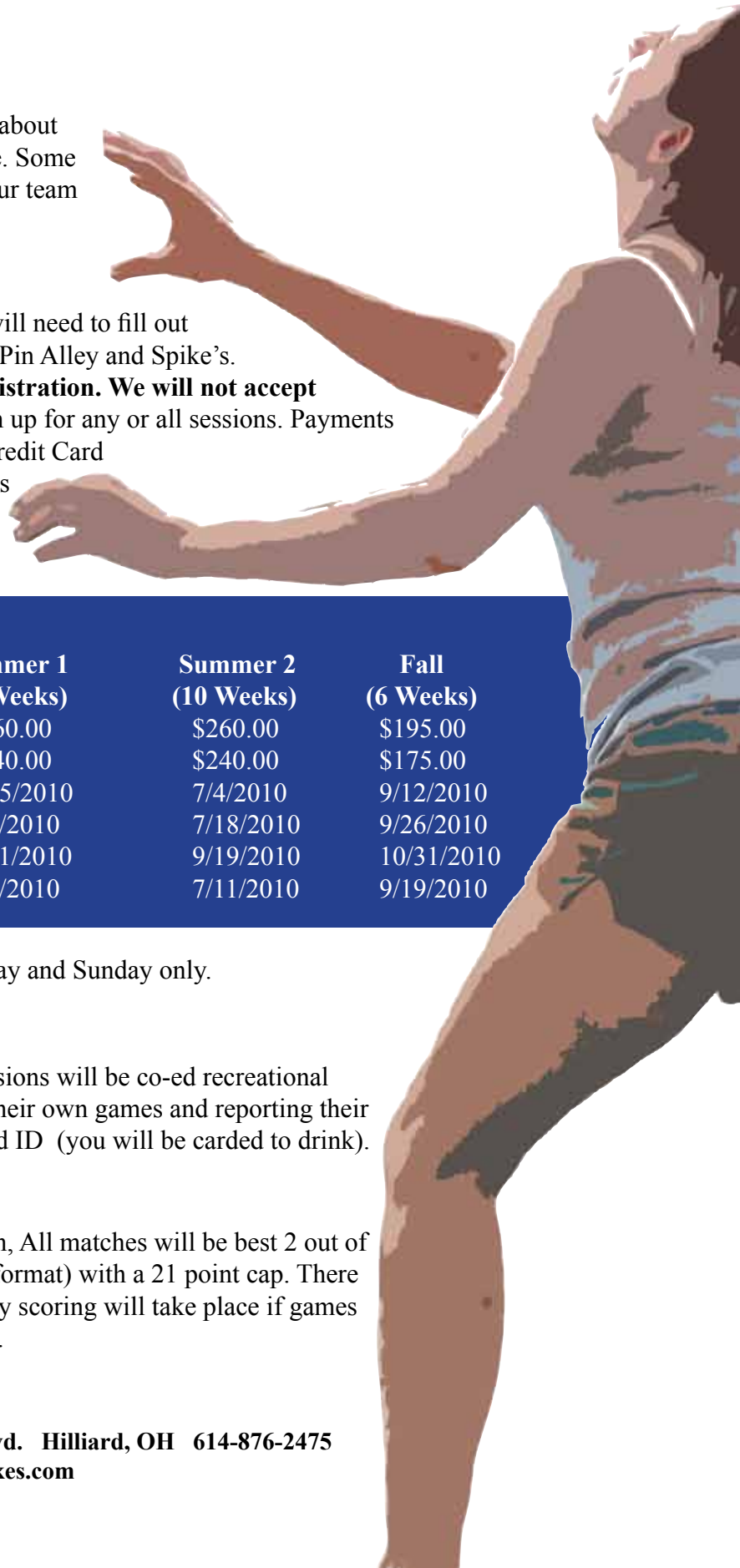
*The available days for the fall session are Thursday and Sunday only.

Teams:

Teams will consist of at least 6 players, and all sessions will be co-ed recreational format. Each team will be responsible for calling their own games and reporting their scores. Players must be 21 or over and carry a valid ID (you will be carded to drink).

Matches:

In order to run volleyball games in a timely fashion, All matches will be best 2 out of 3 games to 15 points, win by 2 (offensive scoring format) with a 21 point cap. There will be a 55 minute time limit for each match. Rally scoring will take place if games are behind at the league representative's discretion.



Session Days and Times:

A minimum of 10 teams is required for any specific day to carry a league. Teams may not request specific times as match times rotate weekly.

Volleyball & House Rules:

Sand Volleyball Rules

- Outdoor USAV rules will apply except when house rules take precedent. Each team captain will be given a rules sheet during the first week of play.
- When serving, the server must stand with both feet behind the boundary line until after the ball has been hit.
- Players are not permitted to lift, hold, or scoop the ball. Each team can hit the ball a maximum number of 3 times. A block is not considered a hit.
- The ball is considered good when it touches the boundary line.
- A ball hit into the net may still be kept in play providing the net is not touched by the players or it's not the third hit.
- Players are not allowed to come from the back to the front to spike.
- Each team must rotate players in a clockwise fashion.
- The ball may come in contact with any part of the body (excluding the head) as long as it does not "rest" against the body.
- Blocking a serve is illegal.
- Serves may be underhand or overhand (no jump serves).
- The ball is out of bounds if it touches any surface, object, or ground outside the sand court. A ball may be played from out-of-bounds from your territory only, however it is illegal to touch the opponent's court in the act of playing a ball.
- If two players contact the ball simultaneously it is considered one hit.
- Players may never cross the plane of the net while attempting a block.
- When spiking the ball, contact must be made on his/her side of the net. The only time you can cross the plane of the net is when following through.
- Each game will be 15 points. Teams must win by 2 with a 21 point cap.
- It will be considered a forfeit for your team if you have less than 4 players. You may play a game "for fun" but it will count as a loss in the standings.
- Teams are co-ed and no more than 4 males may play at one time. If only one female is present, the team will have to play with 3 males and one female. (3 males alone is not permitted - a female must be playing at all times)
- If the ball hits the net and goes over on a serve the ball is dead and is the other team's ball.
- There is a 55 minute time limit on all games. If need be a house representative may have teams RALLY score to keep games on time.
- Spike's volleyball coordinator has the authority to make all final decisions not covered in the above rules.

Spike's Patio House Rules

- Pets are prohibited at Ten Pin Alley and Spike's and not allowed on the patio or outside area.
- Glass is NOT permitted anywhere out on the patio or sand area.
- Outside food and/or alcohol cannot be brought into Ten Pin Alley and Spike's. If you do you will be asked to leave.
- If a team cannot make a scheduled game, it is that team's responsibility to contact the other team to reschedule. The match must be scheduled with Spike's volleyball coordinator.
- Each team will be required to fill out a roster with signatures of each player. Players may be added each week excluding the tournament week (unless authorized by league coordinator). If any player participates without signing a roster that teams games will be forfeited.
- Games will never be cancelled prior to game time due to weather. They may be cancelled at game time due to severe weather.
- Tournament format will seed 1 vs. 24, 2 vs. 23 and so on (provided there are 18 teams on that scheduled night.) The tournament will be played 1 game to 15 points with a double-elimination format. All teams will be required to be present at the beginning of the tournament.
- Spike's Patio may have volleyballs for use but it is each team's responsibility to BRING THEIR OWN BALL.
- Anyone under the age of 18 is not permitted on or around the volleyball courts.
- COURT RESERVATIONS: All courts will be open for practice when matches are not scheduled and are free of charge to all league members. If you would like to reserve a court for parties we charge \$30 per court per hour. (This must be scheduled with Spike's in advance and anyone playing must fill out a waiver form.)
